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**Grape varietal:** Nebbiolo

**Soil:** calcareous/clayey, marnoso

**Exposure:** south, south/west

**Harvest time:** October

**Vinification:** maceration in contact with the grape skins for a duration of 10 days, alcoholic fermentation in steel tanks for 20 days, malolactic fermentation and ageing in French oak barrels for 18 months

**In the glass:** a wine with a fascinating and intriguing bouquet, with hints of dark berries and eucalyptus. Persistent and full-bodied with a citrus aftertaste
