BAROLO 2008

The 2008 Barolo is a pretty, entry-level wine graced with exquisite finesse in its sweet red berries, flowers and spices. This is a classic La Morra Barolo with tons of early appeal. Floral notes add freshness on the refined finish. Anticipated maturity: 2012-2018.

BAROLO GALLINOTTO 2008

The 2008 Barolo Vigna Gallinotto emphasizes up-front fruit and an accessible, juicy personality. It shows fine overall balance but a little less complexity than the very best wines in this vintage. Crushed flowers, mint and tobacco are woven together nicely on the long, focused finish. Anticipated maturity: 2016-2023.

BAROLO GANCIA 2008

The 2008 Barolo Vigna Gancia impresses for its depth, richness and overall complexity. Sweet dark cherries, spices, licorice and subtle hints of French oak flesh out beautifully in this deep, resonant, totally beautiful Barolo. The Gancia shows off striking nuance and a beautifully layered, expressive finish. I imagine the Gancia will drink well upon release and continue to improve for at least another decade. This is a terrific effort from the Molino family. Anticipated maturity: 2014-2023.

BAROLO VIGNA CONCA 2008

The 2008 Barolo Vigna Conca presents a rich, deep expression of fruit. This is the most powerful of the Molino Baroli. French oak gives the wine much of its textural volume and shape. The firm tannins could use another year or so to soften, but I wouldn't wait too long to enjoy the Conca. Anticipated maturity: 2015-2023.
