MAURO MOLINO BAROLO VIGNA CONCA 2008

SCORE 94

Intense aromas of dried fruits with treacle tart and Turkish delight undertones. Chocolate too. Full body, with a rich center palate of fruit and hints of new oak at the finish. This well-crafted wine needs at least three or four years of bottle age to come together.

MAURO MOLINO BAROLO VIGNA GANCIA 2008

SCORE 93

A subtle yet opulent wine with milk chocolate, dried berry and treacle tart character on the nose and palate. Full body with well-integrated tannins and a delicious finish. So yummy now, but will improve many years ahead.

MAURO MOLINO BAROLO GALLINOTTO 2008

SCORE 93

A wine with ripe plums and milk chocolate character follow through to a full body, with toasted oak character and coffee and ripe fruit undertones. The palate is dense and structured. Sweet tannins. Best in 2015.

MAURO MOLINO BAROLO 2008

SCORE 93

Excellent aromas of licorice, dark fruits and dark chocolate with hints of stone. Full-bodied, with ultra-racy, fine tannins and a long and beautiful finish. A wine with very integrated tannins. Such beauty. Extremely well done. Better in a couple of years.
